



D-27-1 Schooner Cove

Type of Boom Harbor

Length of Boom 1950 feet *Unless otherwise indicated, the boom length given is straight line distance as measured on the map. Actual length required will vary with conditions, and increase with current.*

Strategy Implementation

Deploy 750' of harbor boom from Leighton Point to small island at entrance to Schooner Cove; deploy 900' of harbor boom from small island to point of land west of the island; deploy 300' of harbor boom across entrance to Long Cove.
