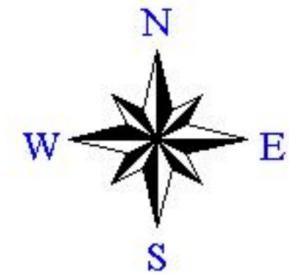



D-28-1 South Bay & Federal Harbor



Collection Points	Cove at Hackins Ledge; small cove north side of Horan Head		
Environmental Concerns	Eelgrass, shellfish beds and shorebirds in both Federal Bay and South Harbor. Seal haulouts at both outer and inner South Bay. Bald eagle nesting sites on Horan Head and Long Island. Urchin aquaculture sites seaward of Horan Head and Black Head.
