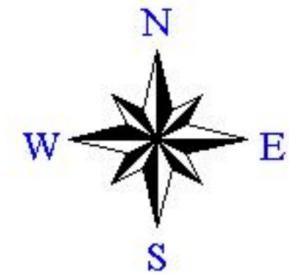



D-36-1 Lamb Cove


