


State Poverty Rate: Population Living In Poverty


Elder Population Rate: Population Age 65 or Older


Disability Population Rate: Maine Adults with Disabilities


TANF Benefit Rate: Maine People Receiving TANF


Chronic Disease Rates: Overall Cancer Incidence


Chronic Disease Rates: Diabetes Prevalence Among Maine Adults


Chronic Disease Rates: Maine Adults with Asthma


Chronic Disease Rates: Maine Children and Youth with Asthma


Chronic Disease Rates: Major Cardiovascular Disease (CVD) Deaths


Mental Health: Population Who Receive Public Mental Health Services (Rate per 1000)


Co-occurring Mental Health & Substance Abuse Disorders: Adult MH Service Recipients with SA Condition


Co-occurring Mental Health & Substance Abuse Disorders: Children MH Service Recipients with SA Condition


Smoking Rate: Adult Smoking Prevalence (Percent Who Are Current Smokers)


Smoking Rate: Mothers Who Smoked During Pregnancy


Smoking Rate: Maine Youths Who Smoked At Least Once In the Past 30 Days


Obesity Rate: Maine Adults Who are Over-Weight or Obese


Obesity Rate: Maine High School Youths Over-weight or Obese


Infant Mortality Rate


Child Abuse & Neglect: Substantiated Cases of Child Abuse (Rate per 10,000)


Children & Youth In DHHS Custody


Elder & Adult Abuse: Number of Referrals for Elder and Adult Abuse or Neglect


Adults and Elders In Public Guardianship


One Year Old Children with Elevated Lead Levels


**Health Care Costs: Average MaineCare Expenditures


**Emergency Department Visits:


Dental Care: Children Receiving Preventive Dental Care


Dental Care: Emergency Department Visits for Adult MaineCare Members


Dental Care: Adults with Routine Dental Visits in Past Year


Long Term Care (LTC): Setting Where LTC is Received


Placements for Children in DHHS Custody




Nutrition: Maine Residents Who Receive Food Stamps


**Nutrition: Food Stamp Participation Rate


Childhood Immunizations: Children Receiving Recommended Immunizations By 24 Months of Age


Asthma: Emergency Department Visits


Diabetes: Adults Who Received Annual Hemoglobin A1c Test at Least Once Yearly


Cardiovascular Disease: Hospitalizations for Acute Myocardial Infarctions (per 10,000 citizens)


Cardiovascular Disease: Hospitalizations for Acute Stroke






MH Consumer Functioning: Children Receiving MH Services Maintaining or Improving Functioning


Substance Abuse: Completion of Substance Abuse Treatment


Substance Abuse: Readmission to Detoxification Unit Within 180 Days of Discharge


Employment: Adults with Developmental Disabilities




Community Inclusion: Adults with Developmental Disabilities Who Participate in Community Activities


Achieving Permanency for Children in DHHS Custody


**Nursing Facility Quality of Care:


**Nursing Facility Quality of Care:


**Nursing Facility Quality of Care:


Nursing Facility Quality of Care: Residents with Excessive Weight Loss


