

Chapter 287: RULES FOR FAMILY PLANNING FUNDING

---

Summary: This chapter requires all funding provided through state government for family planning services comply with the current Federal Title X regulations.

---

1. Definitions

Contracts. Legal agreement between state government and community organizations for the purpose of providing funding for family planning services.

Family Planning Services. Medical, social, and referral services provided to reduce unintended pregnancy.

Title X. Program guidelines for project grants for family planning services promulgated by the Federal Government.

2. Funding for family planning rules

All state contracts for family planning services must include assurances that the contractor will comply with Federal Title X Program Guidelines for Project Grants for Family Planning Services as published in the federal register June 3, 1980. Section 1008. [300a-6] states "None of the funds appropriated under this title shall be used in programs where abortion is a method of family planning." Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations Section 50 Subpart C provides guidance for the non-allowability of the use of federal funds to support the provision of abortion services, except in cases where the life of the mother is endangered, rape, and incest.
