Joe will write something up re: EPA's guidance re: cooking loss.

Tony will find picture of NY advisories to help clarify the description of those advisories.

Tony will add language re: risk management – the point is a reader shouldn't take the information presented in this chapter and expect to develop the same advice as a state may have – the states modify the advice to make it consistent, communicable, etc.

Joe pointed out that there are two uses of cooking loss – one is explicitly folding it into the risk calculation, for which you need to give some sort of information that the advice is dependent on following the cooking and trimming directions. The other option is to include information about cooking loss, but then point out the advisories are derived without that assumption built into the advice. Joe will add something to include that.

Also wanted to point out exceptions re: Hg and other fish – but for this project we are just looking at striped bass and bluefish, so a little cleaner. The general feeling was that the point of the cooking/trimming loss discussion was just to make sure it was on the table for discussion among the larger organizational workgroup.
