Outline of the LEAD-Me Elimination Plan Review Process

LEAd-ME Members,

Below is an outline of the Elimination Plan review process:

To breakdown the Elimination Plan into a workable review process that allows input and engagement from all Advisory Council members it was decided that reviews and comments will happen electronically and at the LEAd-ME meetings themselves. The thought is to include everyone, streamline the process and not put an untold burden on members.

1. At the August 13th meeting...the First Revised Section (“Background”) was distributed
 - Please Review and make comments on the section over the next 3 weeks
 - This Section will also be posted on the website for review
 - Please Send your comments, changes, remarks to Eric Frohberg (eric.frohberg@maine.gov)
 - All comments and changes will be posted (but not attributed to anyone). This will help reduce duplication, and allow others to see what has been suggested.
2. Eric and the CLPPP Program will review and incorporate changes as needed.
3. After 3 weeks of public comment a preliminary Draft will be posted (one week before the next LEAd-ME meeting)
4. At the next meeting the “Background” Section will be discussed and reviewed as a group. We encourage all members to be prepared to discuss the preliminary draft sections scheduled for each meeting.
 - Then the next section (“Existing State Infrastructure”) will be distributed for review over the next month
5. Each month a new revised section will be distributed at the meeting
 - The first half of each meeting will be dedicated to the discussing the comments and review of the designated section.
 - The second half will be reserved for presentations by Lead Poisoning Prevention partners and updates
6. The Schedule is flexible enough to allow additional time to be spent on specific sections and/or add new sections (and if meeting are cancelled (snow, H1N1)
