

Child Care Immunization Standards

These standards will apply to the following facilities: Child Care Center, Child Care Facility, Small Child Care Facility, Home Child Care, Public Pre-school Programs, Nursery Schools, Pre-K programs, Early Kindergarten, 4 year old programs or any child development programs under the control of the State Department of Education or under the control of the Office of Child Care and Head start.
