Dear Ms. Powell:

Miles Memorial Hospital (Miles) is requesting a ruling from the Department regarding the applicability of the Certificate of Need (CON) Program to Miles' proposed revisions to its MRI service. Miles seeks confirmation that the revision is not subject to CON review.

Miles proposes to revise its current MRI service contract with InSight Premier in order to become the provider for all MRI services performed at Miles. InSight will continue to make available the existing mobile MRI unit consistent with current Certificate of Need approvals. Miles will carry out all billing of the technical (or global as applicable) fees. Miles will pay InSight fees for the MRI unit and related services.

The proposed revision is not a new service or transfer of ownership, nor does it involve an acquisition of major medical equipment or a capital expenditure above the current review thresholds.
