### **And Notice of Beginning of Review**

The Maine Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) announces that an application for a Certificate of Need (CON) has been received by Collier's Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, Ellsworth Maine, for the following project:

- Description: Construction of Replacement Nursing facility in Ellsworth, Maine  
Estimated Capital Expenditure: \$12,399,713.
- Meeting: Certificate of Need (M.R.S.A. Section 337(5)) requires that a Public Informational Meeting be held.
- Location: This meeting will be held at Collier's Nursing Center, 33 Birch Avenue, Ellsworth, Maine 04605
- Date/Time: August 4, 2011 at 10:30 am. The telephone number to call for directions or information is 667-9336.

Any person may attend the meeting to question the applicant regarding the project, or the Department regarding the conditions that the applicant must satisfy in order to receive a CON for the project.

Upon written request, any person may examine the application, submit comments in writing to the Department regarding the application, and examine the entire record assembled by the Department at any time from the date of publication of this notice until the application process is closed for comment. Comments received regarding the project and other material are made part of the record. The application process will remain open until the preliminary staff analysis is completed.

A determination regarding issuance of a CON will be made by the Commissioner of DHHS on or before October 27, 2011, unless the process is extended as provided for in the regulations.
