RE: Letter of Non-Applicability: LOI- CMMC – Critical Care Bed Proposal

Dear Mr. Gill:

This correspondence responds to yours dated May 29, 2004 in which Central Maine Medical Center proposes to re-designate three existing beds from acute care medical surgical-beds to general /cardiac critical care beds. The capital cost for this project is estimated to be \$1,442,000.

Based on the information you provided, the Department of Health and Human Services has determined that the proposal as written is not subject to review. The project does not require a review as a change in bed complement as it is not an increase in the licensed bed category of a hospital of greater than 10%. It is not a new health service and the total capital cost associated with the project does not exceed \$10,561,095. At any time, you find this threshold for this project is exceeded thereby requiring a review; you will need to apply for a subsequent review of the proposed project.

Our decision was based solely on information provided by the applicant.
