Dear Mr. Connolly:

This correspondence responds to yours dated June 14, 2004 in which Mercy Hospital proposes to convert 2,200 square feet of existing administrative medical office building space to an Occupational/Employee health space. The capital cost for this project is estimated to be less than \$200,000.

Based on the information you provided, the Department of Health and Human Services has determined that the proposal as written is not subject to review. The project does not require a review as a change in bed complement as it is not an increase in the licensed bed category of a hospital of greater than 10%. It is not a new health service and the total capital cost associated with the project does not exceed \$10,561,095. At any time, you find this threshold for this project is exceeded thereby requiring a review; you will need to apply for a subsequent review of the proposed project.

Our decision was based solely on information provided by the applicant.
