Dear Mr. Altholz:

This correspondence responds to yours dated September 14, 2015 and subsequent telephonic communications and emails in which Martin's Point Health Care, Inc. (MPHC) and its wholly owned subsidiaries Martin's Point Generations, LLC, (MPG) and Martin's Point Generations Advantage, Inc. (MPGA), propose modifications to the corporate structure through which the Medicare Advantage HMO is offered. This will be accomplished by transferring all HMO-related contracts and obligations to MPG's new sister company MPGA.

Based on the information you provided, the Department of Health and Human Services has determined that the proposal as described is not subject to review.

Activities or acquisitions by or on behalf of health maintenance organization or a health care facility controlled, directly or indirectly, by a health maintenance organization or combination of health maintenance organizations are exempted from Certificate of Need review (M.R.S.A. 22-A §330).
