Please Note: If mailing samples to a laboratory, it is recommended that you check with the individual laboratory to see if they have made provisions to enable receipt of bacteria samples within the holding times for the postal service area from which you are sending the water sample. Many Laboratories do offer statewide service. Laboratories are certified by test so it is necessary to check with a laboratory to find out exactly what they are certified for. The tests which laboratories are able to do can change regularly. You may confirm what tests are done by a laboratory or ask any other questions regarding laboratory quality by calling The State of Maine Drinking Water Program at 207-287-2070 and ask for the Laboratory Certification Officer.
