The Meeting commenced immediately after the geothermal construction rules public hearing at 9:00 A.M.

Approval of September 23, 2011 meeting minutes:

Don Robbins motions to approve the September 23, 2011 minutes as amended. Dwight Doughty 2^{nd} the motion. Commission approves.

Pending Complaints:

Complaint received from: Ron Poulin

<u>Allegation</u>: Ferrous smell. Ph of 5.5. Iron and manganese level high. Acidic water probably coming in from the surface. Water gushing in below the casing.

Well Drilling Company: James Philbrick Well Drilling

Responsible Master Driller: James Philbrick

Fact Finding:

There is communication between the two wells. It is not directly but there is communication. Goodwin Well and Water made three attempts to repair the well and could not.

Commission action:

Ike Goodwin recused himself and was present for information only.

Don Robbins moves that the $1^{\rm st}$ well be video inspected and get lab results from both wells. The $1^{\rm st}$ well will need test BA. David Braley $2^{\rm nd}$ the motion. Commission approves. Passed.

Homeowner and driller both need to be notified of a date and time so that they may be present.

Owner is to be Cynthia Austin.

<u>Allegation</u>: Well Drilled does not meet the minimum requirement of no closer than 100 feet to the leach field.

Well Drilling Company: Affordable Well Drilling

Responsible Master Driller: James Bisson

Commission action:

Affordable Well Drilling will contact the homeowner to bring them up to speed.

David Braley will contact the homeowner about getting permission to go on-site and measure the distances.

Commission informed Affordable Well Drilling that a contract should not say that the homeowner is responsible for placement of well meeting all state and local codes. That is the responsibility of the driller.

Specialty Well Applications:

Wells Unlimited: Doug Wright: Don Robbins moves to approve Wells Unlimited, Inc specialty well application with the following conditions and point of facts; that the commission recognizes the potential of contaminant from the holding tank and road runoff, that we require the following conditions:

1. A minimum of 50 feet of casing with a minimum of 30 feet into bedrock

- 2. The annulus is grouted to the surface
- 3. Homeowners must verify that the well will not be in the State of Maine right of way
- 4. Wells Unlimited must notify the Commission 48 hours prior to grouting

The presence of the Saco River is a mitigating factor in the decision. Dwight Doughty 2^{nd} . Commission approves. Passed.

Reilly Well Drilling: Paul Kelsey: If Reilly Well Drilling can get the 40 feet, that's what they are required to do.

Ike motions to approve the specialty well application with 120 feet of casing, grouted and an inspector on-site during grouting because it is the $1^{\rm st}$ specialty well application that has been approved requiring grouting by Reilly Well Drilling. Don Robbins $2^{\rm nd}$. Commission approves. Passed.

Board Clerk will call and find out if he can get more than 40 feet; he can submit a new application and application can be done "in house."
