MAINTENANCE Cleaning

After you complete the INTENSIVE cleaning, do a **MAINTENANCE** cleaning every one to two weeks.

- 1. Concentrate on where your child spends the most time
- 2. Use the wet cleaning method
 - ☐ Avoid sweeping. Mop instead.
- 3. Wear disposable gloves
- 4. Start at the top and work down
