

## **Risk Factors:**



Were people who injected drugs



Were people experiencing homelessness

# Baby

Were born between 1945-1965



Were people with multiple sex partners



Were people who used non-injection drugs

## **Contact Investigations:**



• 50% of patients were hospitalized

- 98% of patients had symptoms
- 100% of patients had elevated liver enzyme lab
- 76% of patients had jaundice



#### Prevention:

- · Get vaccinated against hepatitis B
- · Do not share syringes or injection kit equipment
- Practice safe sex
- · Do not share razors, toothbrushes, or tattooing or piercing needles
- · Get tested for hepatitis B, especially if you are a person who injects drugs, were ever incarcerated, were born between 1945-1965, or received an unlicensed
- If you have hepatitis B, seek medical care
