## **School-Located Vaccine Clinic - Roster Billing 2011-2012 Influenza Season**

School-Located Vaccine Clinics (SLVC) will be eligible to directly bill for vaccine administration to MaineCare-eligible clients through the ImmPact2 system. Maine CDC and MaineCare have coordinated this opportunity for the second year and are pleased to announce the continuation of this billing option.

To utilize this functionality, the following criteria must be met:

- The school must be enrolled in the ImmPact2 system as a SLVC Location
- The School and/or Medical Provider (MP) must use ImmPact2 for client data entry
- The client data must be entered via the School Profile
- The School Profile must have a MaineCare-specific National Provider Identification (NPI) which consists of a 10-digit NPI plus a 3-digit MaineCare identifier. This NPI may belong to the School or the MP as indicated in the MOA section of the SLVC registration form.
- The NPI must be entered in the NPI Agency Setup area of ImmPact2

### **Business Process**

User Logs into ImmPact2 via the School Profile  
Click the Mass Immunization Menu Item  
Record Client/Student data via the Roster Data Entry (Mass Immunization) Module

Doses entered into ImmPact2 will automatically be checked for MaineCare eligibility. Providers will not have to verify the member's eligibility or MaineCare numbers.

Billing will be generated by Maine CDC, or assignee, and transmitted to MaineCare. Clients included in the billing will be those who have been entered via the Mass Immunization Module, are MaineCare-eligible, and have an NPI indicated for the administered location/school.

This functionality is available only for State-Supplied Vaccine and Private Vaccine. MaineCare payment will appear on a Remittance Advice Statement. MaineCare's payment will be for the vaccine administration fee only.
