Dear School Vaccine Clinic Coordinator,

This notice is being sent to all schools that have registered to participate in school-located influenza vaccine clinics (SLVC) this fall.

Maine CDC is pleased to announce that certain vaccine clinic supplies will be available for free to schools offering SLVC this year. During the SLVC registration process, we asked you to identify an SAU contact. This information will be used to create a user account with McKesson Medical-Surgical, which you may use to order up to \$500 in supplies for your SLVC. You will have access to a pre-set list of supplies that may be needed for school vaccine clinics. If you already have all the supplies you need for your clinic, there are also supplies available on this list that may help in the prevention and control of influenza in your school.

How it works

McKesson will be contacting you in the near future with a username and password to access the online catalog. Ordering instructions will be included.

When you sign in using your username and password, you will be prompted to verify your shipping address. Once you have confirmed the shipping address, you may order any supplies from the online catalog developed specifically for SLVC up to a total of \$500. Items will be shipped directly to your designated ship-to address. In-stock items will be shipped for next business day delivery.
