<p><b>This is what mosquitoes use to hear and smell.</b></p> <p>Answer: Antennae</p>	<p><b>This is an example of an artificial container intended to hold water for one of the mosquitoes hosts.</b></p> <p>Answer: Bird bath</p>
<p><b>The first stage of the mosquito life cycle- the female mosquito lays 50 – 300 of these about every third day of their lifespan.</b></p> <p>Answer: Eggs</p>	<p><b>This furry animal is a dead end host for EEE</b></p> <p>Answer: Horse</p>

<p><b>This is a host that walks on two legs and can become infected when one of the infected mosquitoes bites them, but can't infect other mosquitoes, which makes them "dead-ends" for the disease.</b></p> <p>Answer: Humans</p>	<p><b>Mosquito repellent should be approved by this.</b></p> <p>Answer: Environmental Protection Agency</p>
<p><b>This natural container can hold water and become part of mosquitoes' habitat</b></p> <p>Answer: hole in a tree</p>	<p><b>This is one of the favored habitats for mosquitoes carrying Eastern equine encephalitis virus (EEEV)</b></p> <p>Answer: Swamp</p>
<p><b>This is the part of the mosquito's body that holds the blood that the female takes in, as well as stores the female's eggs.</b></p> <p>Answer: Abdomen</p>	<p><b>This is not a favored habitat for mosquitoes.</b></p> <p>Answer: Waterfall- due to moving water</p>
<p><b>This discarded item is the #1 breeding location for mosquitoes .</b></p> <p>Answer: Tire</p>	<p><b>This image shows where the risk of EEEV is found in Maine</b></p> <p>Answer: Map of Maine's counties</p>

<p><b>The gas that all animals exhale that can attract mosquitoes from several hundred feet away</b></p> <p>Answer: Carbon Dioxide</p>	<p><b>This prevention method minimizes skin exposure to mosquitoes</b></p> <p>Answer: Wearing long pants and sleeves</p>
<p><b>This image identifies the mosquito's thorax.</b></p> <p>Answer: Thorax (the part of the mosquito where the wings and legs attach)</p>	<p><b>This is a common item for plants, but may attract mosquitoes if there is sitting water for over a week.</b></p> <p>Answer: Flower pot</p>
<p><b>This repellent is approved for use on clothing</b></p> <p>Answer: Permethrin</p>	<p><b>This is the time of day when mosquitoes are most active</b></p> <p>Answer: Dusk and dawn</p>
