This update summarizes reports of pertussis infection in persons reported during 2012 received by the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention (Maine CDC) during January 1 – September 20, 2012.

There have been a total of 519* confirmed and probable pertussis cases reported statewide through Sep 20, 2012, compared to 106 reported cases in 2011 during the same period. *Additional cases may have occurred especially in the most recent weeks that are not included in this report.




