## Maine HIV Diagnoses, January 1st to December 31st, 2015

Between January 1 and December 31, 2015, 48 newly diagnosed HIV cases were reported to the Maine CDC. Prevalence data provided in the table below show that male to male sexual contact accounts for the majority of HIV transmissions in Maine. While most diagnoses were seen in the 30-39 year age range, new diagnoses were reported in people 9 to 70 years of age. Of the 48 newly reported HIV cases, 10 of those also received an AIDS diagnosis within one month of testing positive for HIV. There were a total of AIDS 26 cases diagnosed in Maine in 2015. Current records indicate that 1766 of Maine's residents are infected with HIV. The table below presents demographic data for newly diagnosed and prevalent HIV cases in Maine.
