




Number of cases of gonorrhea in 2017

Co-Infections:



Of cases overall identified as MSM


Maine Surveillance Report | 2017

Demographics:



7% increase from 2016-2017 in female cases

Black/African Americans had a case rate that was nearly 12 times that of their White counterparts (3.99 per 1,000 vs. .34 per 1,000)



- · Use condoms consistently and regularly.
- · Reduce amount of sexual partners.
- Eliminate or reduce drug and/or alcohol use before and during intercourse.
- Choose to not participate in risky sexual behavior.
