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Returning Wasted and Expired Vaccine

VFC Requirements – Provider Must:

- Develop and maintain complete, accurate and separate stock records.
- Notify immunization program of any vaccine soon to expire.
- Remove expired vaccine from storage unit to prevent inadvertent administration.
- Transfer vaccine only with the approval of the immunization program.
- Send returns to McKesson within six months after expiration/spoilage date and 30 days of reconciliation, receipt of a Return Authorization Number (RA#) and request for labels. If this is not done within the required time, your RA# will expire and be cancelled by CDC. You will then have to request a new Return Authorization Number. If you do not have your label within 10 to 14 business days please call MIP at 1-800-569-0659 to speak with Vaccine Management.
- Products with Multiple NDCs, use NDC on outer box.

Change in Cap Color for Sanofi IPOL® Vials

Effective immediately, SANOFI PASTEUR has changed the cap color of IPOL® vials, NDC 49281-0860-10, from green to orange. Providers who receive shipments of IPOL® from the McKesson Memphis Distribution Center will begin to see the vials with the new orange cap color within the next week or two. It will be a few weeks before the McKesson Sacramento Distribution Center begins shipping the IPOL® vials with the new orange cap color.



New Merck Shipping Containers

Merck will begin using new shipping containers for delivery of frozen vaccine products.


Here are some of the changes implemented with the new shipping containers:

- Boxes will be more identifiable because of Merck's logo on the banding straps and Merck's name on top
 of box.
- New handles and symbols to reduce mismanagement and/or misplacement of the container.
- Easy-to-read instructions are on the outside stressing immediate storage and handling is needed.
- A pamphlet on the inside to reiterate the important storage and handling required for the product, as well as instruction about how to recycle the container.
- Reinforced interior design to better protect product from shifting and possibly being crushed in transit.
- Bubble wrap included to keep product secure and dry.
