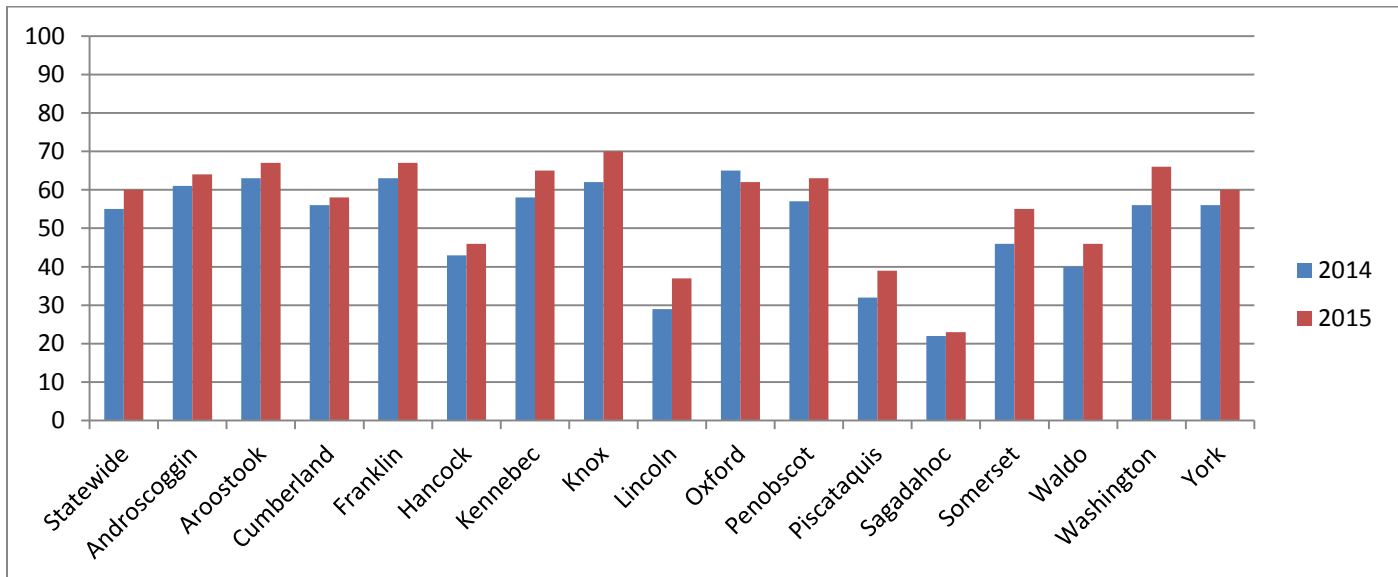

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Maine Immunization Program
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2014 – 2015 Adolescent Immunization Rate Assessment Comparison Report

The Maine Immunization Program conducts an immunization assessment on the 1st of each quarter (January, April, July, October) which includes all adolescents in the State of Maine immunization registry, ImmPact, associated to a practice which enters client specific data. These assessments follow the standard Centers for Disease Control and Prevention adolescent assessment criteria of 13-18 years of age immunized for 1 Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis): 2 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella): 3 HepB (Hepatitis B): 2 Var (Varicella): and 1 MCV (Meningococcal Conjugate).
