

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## Adolescent Immunization Rate Assessment Report 2015 Second Quarter – April 1, 2015

The Maine Immunization Program conducts an immunization assessment on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each quarter (January, April, July, October) which includes all adolescents in the State of Maine immunization registry, ImmPact, associated to a practice which enters client specific data. These assessments follow the standard Centers for Disease Control and Prevention adolescent assessment criteria of 13-18 years of age immunized for 1 Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis): 2 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella): 3 HepB (Hepatitis B): 2 Var (Varicella): and 1 MCV (Meningococcal Conjugate).
