

Proportion Of Adolescents In Grades 9-12 Who Have Never Had Sexual Intercourse Maine And US Selected Years 1995-2005







High Risk (HIV) Individuals Who Test For HIV At Public Sites Maine




Chlamydia Trachomatis Infection Rates By Gender Maine Residents Aged 15-24 2000-2005


Maine Residents with Concurrent HIV/AIDS Diagnoses 2000 - 2004
