Uninsured women undergoing treatment for breast or cervical cancer may qualify for MaineCare. Please call for more information.

You May Get Free Services if:

- 1. You are a Maine woman, age 40* or older, and
- You have no health insurance, or your health insurance does not cover mammograms or Pap tests or you have a high deductible, and
- **3.** You meet income guidelines at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level
 - * Limited openings for women age 35-39 who have seen a doctor and need additional tests for a possible breast or cervical cancer OR if they have not had a Pap in 5 or more years.
