



MAINE STATE LAW:

It is illegal for us to sell,
furnish, give or deliver liquor to
a person under 27 years of age
without requiring an ID to
verify the person is over 21.



It is unlawful for us to:

- ◆ Serve liquor to someone under 21 or allow them to consume alcohol on this premise
- ◆ Serve liquor to someone who is visibly intoxicated, or allow that person to remain on this premise



If we suspect an ID is fraudulent, we will refuse to serve that party alcohol.

We may also exercise our right under Maine state law to retain the ID and turn it over to law enforcement.
