

SPF SIG Monthly Summary May 2010

Workgroups:

- **SPF Advisory Board:** Did not meet this month. Next meeting scheduled for June 10, 2010.

- **Community Epidemiology Surveillance Network:** The Spring 2010 CESN report was finalized and posted at <http://www.maine.gov/dhhs/osa/data/cesn/index.htm>.

Other Items:

- KIT Prevention Customization Workgroup (PCW): Met on 05/07/10. Discussed timelines for editing KIT; community representation during RFP times; and development of a guide for KIT once edits are made.
- Office of Substance Abuse (OSA) finished the last of their Substance Abuse Prevention Conference Call Series. May 20, 2010 marked the last conference call in the series entitled Substance Abuse Prevention: What's Next?
- May 17-19 the SPF SIG conference was held in Maryland.
- Site visits to the local Health Maine Partnerships have almost all been complete. Reports of site visits are being written and will be provided to the local coalitions.
- OSA has been in the process of reviewing applications which combine Block Grant, Fund for Healthy Maine, and Enforcing Underage Drinking Law funds; renewing contracts for the Health Maine Partnerships; and renewing contracts for the Youth Substance Abuse Prevention Programs and Student Intervention Reintegration Program.
- 2011 Healthy Maine Partnership RFP Program Development work is ongoing at this time.
- OSA and DOE have partnered together to apply for the Safe and Drug Free Schools Bridging Grant that is due to the US Department of Education on June 7th.
- Prevention Provider Day is in the planning phases for November 4, 2010; the planning committee will meet on June 4, 2010.
- SPF staff worked with the Penobscot Tribal Nations around their needs assessment, which OSA is helping to fund, utilizing Center for Substance Abuse Prevention SPF SIG funding.
- SPF staff attended the CSAP cohort 2-4 National conference to present on OSA's SPF capacity building activities.
