Definitions:

- A **crisis stabilization unit** provides short-term, out-of-home treatment for a person experiencing a mental health crisis. The codes for crisis services for youth are: H0018 Child Crisis Residential - Crisis Units and H0019HA Child PNMI - Crisis Residential.
- **ALOS** - average length of stay in days of members discharged in CareConnecton® from child crisis units during this month.
- **Courtesy Review** - APS completes courtesy reviews when a member is not MaineCare eligible at the time of admission, but is expected to be served using either MaineCare and/or state funds.

What This Report Measures: Average length of stay of members discharged from child crisis units during this month. Members may be discharged more than once.

Total number of members discharged = 66 Average length of stay (ALOS) in days = 14 Median length of stay in days = 6
