Definitions:

- **Home and Community Based Treatment (HCT)** is a higher intensity community-based mental health service than Outpatient Therapy but a lower intensity service than Children's Assertive Community Treatment (ACT). There are 3 types of HCT services.
 - **HCT** is the regular home and community based treatment service.
 - **HCT - FFT** is home and community based treatment service using the evidenced based treatment model of family functional therapy.
 - **HCT - MST** is home and community based treatment service using the evidenced based treatment model of multi-systems therapy.
- **ALOS** - average length of stay in days of members discharged in CareConnecton® from children's home and community based treatment during this month.
- **Courtesy Review** - APS completes courtesy reviews when a member is not MaineCare eligible at the time of admission, but is expected

What This Report Measures: Average length of stay of members discharged from HCT services during this month. Members may be discharged more than once.

Total number of members discharged = 211

Average length of stay (ALOS) in days for all types of HCT services = 147

Average length of stay (ALOS) in days for Regular HCT = 154

Average length of stay (ALOS) in days for HCT - FFT = 92

Average length of stay (ALOS) in days for HCT - MST = 122
