Definitions:

Significantly Better = A significant improvement in functioning is defined as having a CAFAS score at discharge 20 or more points lower than at initial registration.

Might Be Better = CAFAS Point score was 10 points lower at discharge indicating possible improvement, though not statistically significant.

Stayed the same = The CAFAS scores at discharge stayed the same or increased by 10 points from the initial CAFAS score.

Worse = A decline in functioning is defined as having a CAFAS score at discharge more than 20 or more points higher than at initial registration.

What This Report Measures : The CAFAS test is one assessment used to measure of level of functioning. The higher the CAFAS score the more impairments to functioning are present. Only youth in Targeted Case Management for Behavioral Health TCM (T1017UC)with CAFAS scores entered into CareConnection at registration and discharge are included. In addition, to be included the youth must remain in the TCM service for more than 180 days. Youth under age 6 may have complete CAFAS' and be included in this measure, but since the CAFAS is not required for youth under age 6, many youth under age 6 are not included. All scores are compiled below, but only Providers with more than 15 discharges have percents calculated since small numbers make comparisons difficult.
