

Adult Day Care Centers

The USDA Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) provides reimbursement for nutritious meals and snacks served to adults in public or private nonresidential day care centers who are at least 60 years of age or functionally impaired adults of any age who reside in the community.

Reimbursement is based on the income levels of the enrolled adult participants.

Adult day care centers can be reimbursed for up to two meals and one snack, or one meal and two snacks a day for each adult.
