MAC Meeting – July 7, 2009

- **Rule Update (Patty Dushuttle) – See also July policy update:**
 - Numerous rulemaking to meet both July 1st budget initiatives and for MIHMS implementation;
 - Sec. 7 – Dialysis Services – new section of policy but not new service (currently these services are billed under physician policy ;
 - Sec. 62 – Genetic Services – Repealing rule – will continue to be able to bill under physician and laboratory services;

- **Schaller Anderson Update (Carol Bean and Tracey Emerson):**
 - Focus on top 10% of high risk adult population;
 - Top 5% of high risk pediatric population;
 - High cost emergency room use –15 ER or more visits per year;
 - Identify and coordinate select group of chronically ill MaineCare members;
 - Currently 14,000 members are participating with Schaller Anderson;
 - Request to share with the MAC the top 10% high risk and ER use data by diagnosis.

- **OMS Update (Steven Davis):**
 - Targeted Case Management –
 - Draft rule is currently being reviewed by AAG;
 - Unsure of emergency implementation date – working with July 15th;
 - Enrollment Provider forms and notification of training sessions to be sent out today;
 - TCM Groups:
 - Adults – Developmental Disability; Substance Abuse; HIV and Long Term Care;
 - Children – Behavioral Health, Developmental Disabilities and Chronic Medical Care;

- Both – Homeless or at risk of homelessness;
 - Concern about Developmental Delayed children – who may not be eligible for any TCM?
 - When mailing is finalized – send to MAC members;
 - MAC to send recommendation to delay implementation of the rule.
- **OIAS Update (Ron Bansmer):**
- Opened NonCats for enrollment – have increased membership by 2,900 through first notice of opening enrollment;
 - Currently 11,161 members enrolled;
 - Will next determine next group on waiting list to enroll and stay within budget cap;
