SUBJECT: Crisis System Update

The Crisis Work Group has had its first meeting and among other items discussed provider and consumer/family input into our initial work. The Work Group decided to seek input in writing to a structured set of questions and will be addressing this at the next meeting which is scheduled for July 7, 2008. Since AIN had in the last few years conducted a survey of consumer's around Crisis Services, the Work Group decided to review that report prior to determining how to proceed regarding any further consumer and family input. To allow time for responses the Work Group adjusted the work plan below by a month. The following is the revised work plan.
