Other	<p>Muskie - Sharon informed the group this would be the last meeting that Muskie would organize and she thanked them for their work over the years.</p> <p>PNMI – A group has been formed and charged with standardizing PNMI rates. They are looking at 2 rates and need to define what the rates will be. Much discussion followed. If anyone is interested in who is on the committee, Sharon has an attendance sheet. If you want to add feedback, you are encouraged to reach out to members. PNMI members are encouraged to join the workgroup.</p> <p>Statewide Crisis Meeting – This meeting was last Wednesday with the purpose of making sure everyone had baseline information on crisis programs. There will be two rates. The first one will be high and the second one, the old minimum standard rate, will be low. Standards are being developed for the high rate. The process of review will be this summer so agencies can get a clear understanding. The hope is everyone will eventually get the high rate. The new standards become effective July 1, 2011, so they have a year of planning. It is hoped that these rates have consistency for hospitals, consumers, families, community members, crisis providers, etc. and that the community will be responsible for getting the care that is needed.</p>
