
By agreement of counsel, I hereby amend the Compliance Standards adopted on October 29, 2007, in the following respects:

1. Standard IV.36 is hereby amended to read as follows: "90% of crisis phone calls requiring face-to-face assessments are responded to within an average of 60 minutes from the end of the phone call."

2. Standard IV.46 is hereby amended to read as follows: "the Department documents the programs it has sponsored that are designed to improve quality of life and community inclusion for class members, including support of peer centers, social clubs, community connections training, wellness programs, and leadership and advocacy training programs."

3. Standard IV.50 is hereby amended to read as follows: "the Department documents the number and types of mental health informational workshops, forums, and presentations geared toward the general public that are designed to reduce myths and stigma of mental illness and to foster community integration of persons with mental illness."
