CORRECTIONS

1. An error has been found in the MYDAUS data base in Question 38a, “What are the chances that you would be seen as cool if you smoked cigarettes?” (2002 MYDAUS, Appendix C, page 5). This question is one of four used to assess the Peer/Individual Risk Factor, “Rewards for Antisocial Involvement”. (Appendix B – Risk & Protective Factor Definitions, p.67 [erroneously referred to as 48a in printed technical report]). The data in the body of this report that are inaccurate because of this error are on the following pages:

Page 33, 7th bullet

Page 36, Table 14, 3rd row

Page 39, Table 15, 3rd row; [all highlighted cells in Table 15 should be green]

The error does not change the ranking of the three counties with the Highest Risk/Lowest Protection or Lowest Risk/Highest Protection (page 33 and Table 18, page 42.)
