


## Instructions for the DMR Landings Program Dealer Form #2006.3B

**\*\*\*Only report what was bought directly from harvesters (fishermen). If you only bought from licensed dealers, fill out a negative report for that month. If you are an aquaculture company with a dealer license, you are considered the harvester and dealer; in this case, report what you harvested and sold each month.\*\*\***

1. **Dealer Name/License No.:** Name (as it appears on your dealer license) and business license number.
2. **Month and Year:** Month and year the fish/shellfish were landed. Do not fill out multiple positive months on one form.
3. **Signature/Phone:** Signature of person filing the report; phone number where you may be reached for questions.
4. **Avg. Price By Species/Market/Grade:** Fill in the average price/unit the dealer paid the harvester(s) for each species/market/grade that month. Make sure price unit is clear. Example: LOBSTER/SELECT/OLD SHELL = \$8.00/LB
5. **Negative Report:** Check month(s) in which nothing was purchased from harvesters. **Note: negative reports need to be filled out even if you are seasonal. We need to account for you for every month of the year.**
6. **Day:** Day fish/shellfish were landed.
7. **Harvester ID:** Full name or license number of the harvester.
8. **Boat:** The full name or hull number of the harvester's boat (if applicable).
9. **Port Landed:** Name of the town (port) in which the fish/shellfish were landed. For intertidal species (shellfish, worms, elvers, etc), this is the town in which the fish/shellfish were harvested.
10. **Species:** Use species code list (Table 1) for what was purchased. **All species purchased from harvesters must be reported.**
11. **Market:** Use market category list (Table 2); this describes the product size.
12. **Grade:** Use grade code list (Table 3); this describes the product condition at the time of landing.
13. **Unit:** In what unit you are reporting the fish/shellfish. Examples: POUNDS, BUSHEL, COUNT, etc.
14. **Amount:** How many of the units were purchased.
15. **Gear:** Use gear code list (Table 4); what gear was used to harvest the fish/shellfish.
16. **Use:** See use code list (Table 5); this is what the product will be used for.
17. **Dealer Use:** Space for dealer to note any extra information.
18. Report forms are due by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month.
19. Mail yellow copy or fax reports to the address at the top of the forms. If you want to email reports to DMR, call 207.633.9504. Forms can also be found online at: [www.maine.gov/dmr](http://www.maine.gov/dmr) (follow link to Commercial Fishing).

 Just before you run out of forms, send a note with a landings report that says, "SEND MORE FORMS" and some will be mailed to you promptly.
