

## NOTICE OF EMERGENCY RULE-MAKING

### BASIS STATEMENT

The Commissioner of the Maine Department of Marine Resources amends the emergency DMR Chapter 95.10 D, Closed Area No. 4-A, Perkins Cove, Ogunquit, amended on July 25, 2002. This amendment changes the area number from 4-A to 5, changes the title and creates a larger prohibited area due to licensed overboard discharges, no harvestable resource and lack of shoreline survey. As authorized by 12 M.R.S.A. §§6172, 6192, 6193 & 6194 the Commissioner of Marine Resources adopts emergency amendments to Chapter 95.10 D.

**RULE TITLE AND SUBJECT:** DMR Chapter 95.10 D, Closed Area No. 4-A, Perkins Cove, Ogunquit, amended on July 25, 2002, is amended as follows:

**TITLE & TEXT OF RULE:** DMR Chapter 95.10(D), Closed Area No. 5 ~~4-A, Perkins Cove, Ogunquit~~ Bald Head Cliff (York) to Israels Head (Ogunquit)

Effective immediately, because of pollution, it shall be unlawful to dig, take or possess any clams, quahogs, oysters or mussels taken from the shores, flats and waters inside and west of a line beginning at Bald Head Cliff (York) ~~the southeasternmost point of Perkins Cove~~ and extending northwest ~~to the northeasternmost point of Perkins Cove, Ogunquit.~~ tip of Israels Head (Ogunquit).
