**Note: Areas seeded with shellfish taken from Restricted (Closed) areas must be closed for a period of at least 60 days. Areas seeded with clams taken from Prohibited (Closed) areas must be closed for a period of at least 6 months. This applies to any transplant listed above where 'Approved' is NOT checked.**

This letter will serve as permission for the above activity provided that the listed Supervisor contacts, 24 hours before the start of the activity, the Municipal Shellfish Warden, the Marine Patrol Officer responsible for this area and the Marine Patrol Division II Office at 667-3373. You may call the Division II Office in advance to determine who will be the local officer on duty and obtain direct contact information. DMR would also request that you work with your area biologist to evaluate the effectiveness of this transplant activity.
