

# Nature Programs

## Wolfe's Neck Woods State Park

Guided nature programs, free with park admission, as scheduled through June 30 at Wolfe's Neck Woods State Park. Starting at 2:00 PM at the benches by the second parking lot, weather permitting. One hour programs may include walks, talks, and activities in a beautiful natural setting. **Special programs will be offered on Saturday, June 6 for first time hikers and experienced hikers at different times from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM.** No reservations needed except for group programs. Park admission is \$1.00 for ages 5-11, \$3.00 for Maine residents ages 12-64, \$4.50 for non residents ages 12-64, \$1.50 for non residents over 65; persons under 5 and Maine residents over 65 are free. Starred (\*) programs are wheelchair accessible, as well as the informal programs meeting at the osprey sign (**O**), or benches (**B**), where you may stop by any time between 2:00 and 3:00 PM. Shore programs (**S**) meet at the shore across from Googins Island and are not wheelchair accessible.

### June

- 6 Forest and Shore Tour for First Time Hikers- 10:00 AM - One** mile hike on the Casco Bay Trail and returning on the Ledge Trail, introducing visitors to the basics and fun of hiking.
- Harraseeket Hike for Experienced Hikers – 1:00 PM - Two** mile hike on the Casco Bay Trail and Harraseeket Trail providing adventure, challenge, and exercise in a beautiful natural setting.
- Osprey Watch\* - 2:00 PM - One** half mile wheelchair accessible tour to a scenic overlook providing views of the rocky shore, islands of the bay, and nesting ospreys while learning their life story.
- 7 The Edge of the Sea –** Enjoy a walk, short talks, and activities on the natural history and ecology of our varied shores.
- 13 Osprey Watch\* (O) -** Get a close look at the ospreys while learning their life story.
- 14 Hike with the Ranger –** Enjoy the best that the park has to offer in this season on this hike with a knowledgeable guide.

- 20 **Casco Bay Walk** – Enjoy views of rocky shores, nesting ospreys, and islands of the bay on this one-mile walk with the park manager.

- 26 **Tree Hunt\***- Stop by the benches to get your papers for this fun, self-guiding hunt, and then come back afterwards to see how well you did.

- 28 **In the Pines\*** - Tour the pine forest on our accessible path and see why Maine is the Pine Tree State.
- 29 **Stories in Stone** – Get to know the story of Mine’s beautiful rockbound coast on this walk with short talks and activities.
- 30 **Osprey Watch\* (O)** - Get a close look at the ospreys while learning their life story.
