Cross-country Skiing:

Aroostook State Park has 15 miles of groomed trails; Camden Hills State Park offers great skiing opportunities, as does nearby Tanglewood 4-H Center

Snowshoeing:

Aroostook State Park has 3 miles of snowshoe trails; Camden Hills State Park also offers good snowshoeing

Snowmobile Riding:

ITS 83 crosses Aroostook State Park property, and connects to the park's trail system; the Allagash Wilderness Waterway is a prime destination for backcountry snowmobile riding

Ice Fishing:

Lake St. George State Park, Damariscotta Lake State Park, the Penobscot River Corridor and the Allagash all offer spectacular ice fishing

Wildlife Watching:

Hike, ski or snowshoe through the Holbrook Island Sanctuary in Brooksville; there are no groomed trails, and snowmobiles and ATVs must be left at home

Winter Camping:

Pitch your tent in the shadow of Quaggy Jo Mountain in Aroostook State Park, or camp in the relative luxury of the 1930's-era ski shelter at Camden Hills State Park

Be sure to let someone know where you'll be, be very careful with fire (in established fire rings only), and carry out whatever you carry in. Then set your skis, strap on your snowshoes, hitch up your boots, and TAKE IT OUTSIDE!
