Requirements for Driver Education Endorsement 7-12 (530)

If you complete all requirements, you will be issued a professional certificate, either a two-year provisional certificate or a five-year professional certificate.

1. Criminal history record check approval – based on fingerprints
2. Valid provisional or professional Maine teaching certificate with a K-8, 7-12, 9-12, OR K-12 endorsement
3. Personal driving record approved by the Department of Education
4. Valid Maine driver's license
5. Valid Maine driver education teacher license issued by the Maine Secretary of State

If this evaluation letter is more than two years old, please contact the certification office, as the requirements may have changed.

A provisional certificate is issued to an applicant who has met all of the requirements but has not taught for two school years in a Maine school with a Professional Learning Community Support System (PLCSS). Once an applicant has taught for two school years in a Maine school and been recommended for a five-year certificate by the local school district's PLCSS, the full five-year certificate will be issued.
