



David L. Silvernail

Dr. David L. Silvernail is adjunct research professor and professor emeritus at the University of Southern Maine. He was the founder and director of the Center for Education Policy, Applied Research and Evaluation (CEPARE) at the University of Southern Maine. He was also a founder and co-director of the Maine Education Policy Research Institute (MEPRI), a non-partisan research institute of the Maine

Legislature and the University of Maine System. For the past 20+ years Dr. Silvernail has been conducting policy research and analysis, and providing technical assistance to the Maine Legislature, Maine State Board of Education, Maine Department of Education, Maine State Planning Office, and other state and regional education agencies.

He has published over 40 journal articles, monographs and book chapters, and provided research and analysis for various agencies in the New England states as well as Alaska and Mississippi. Dr. Silvernail has prepared over 50 research reports and briefing papers for agencies and states on a variety of topics including school funding, school district reorganization, student assessment systems, student equity, poverty and achievement, higher performing, more efficient schools, and higher education participation and performance.

Additionally Dr. Silvernail has provided research and evaluation assistance for over 60 school districts in Maine and across the nation, and he started his professional education career as a middle and high school mathematics and political science teacher.
