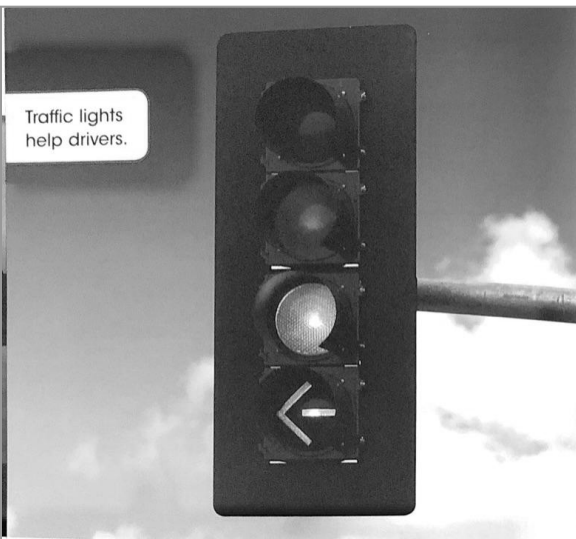

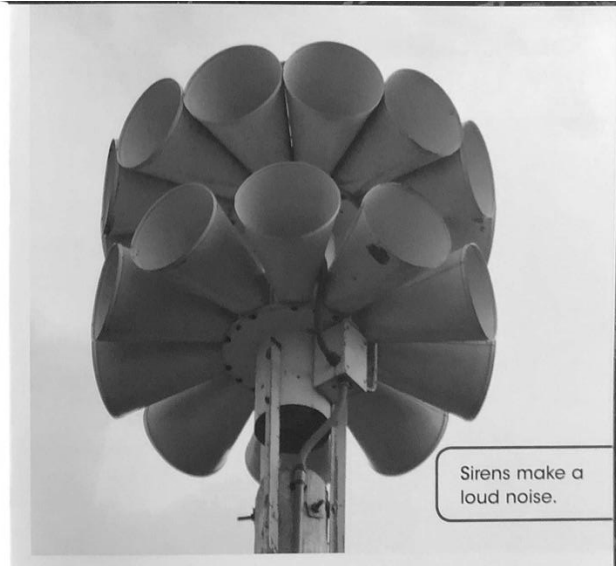

These lights and sounds mean a train is coming.

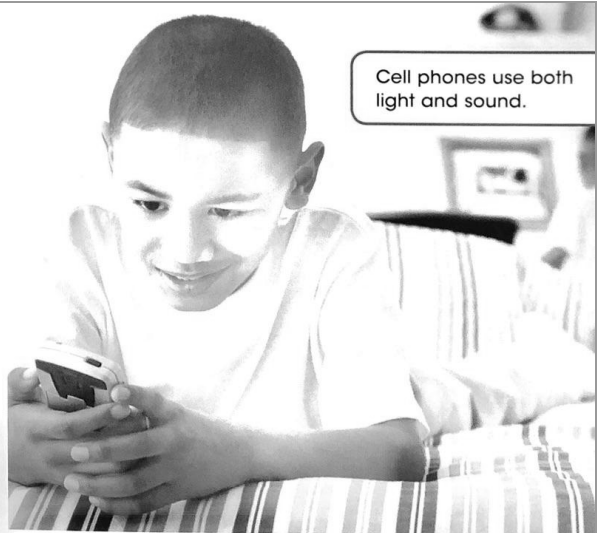
A train crossing has ringing bells and flashing lights.
