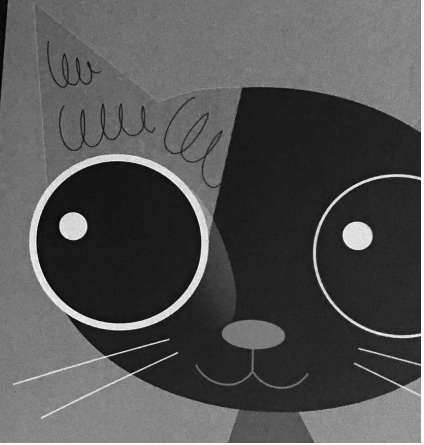
There's a poisonous millipede found in California that lights up at night to warn other animals not to eat it.
