The Mount Desert Public Schools Nutrition Program was reviewed per Federal Regulation 7CFR 210.18 and Maine Department of Education Child Nutrition policies and procedures. On December 6, 2024 David Hartley reviewed Mt. Desert Elementary School. An exit conference with you occurred on December 7, 2024.

Responses must be submitted through CNPweb, Maine Department of Education Child Nutrition's Administrative Review software, and must address the following:

- How this action will ensure future compliance

In accordance with §210.18(k), failure to return completed documentation within 30 days from the corrective action deadline date will result in the withholding of reimbursement payments. We hope that following the exit conference you and your staff addressed the corrective actions and that you will have no problems in meeting the response deadline.

The Official Notification also provides the potential fiscal action, which is an initial estimate of the amount of reimbursement that will be reclaimed. These are only estimates which must be adjusted to the actual date of corrective action for each violation. If documentation of corrective action or acceptable corrective action is not received by the response date stated above, the claim will be recalculated to the end of the school year.

Finding 9000: Other Finding

At the beginning of the breakfast and lunch meal service the reviewer noticed the individual completing accountability was entering students into the POS system while the students were in line prior to receiving the meal. Meal accountability is competed when the student has received a reimbursable meal.

Technical Assistance:

This was immediately explained the individual's completing accountability and corrected.

Meal Components & Quantities - Mt Desert Elementary School (312)

409. Review period production records/documentation - required meal components offered, daily/weekly requirements met? Enter data.

Finding 9075: Production records/supporting documentation indicate weekly meal pattern requirements for the age/grade group(s) not met.

Based on a review of production records and other supporting food crediting documentation for 1 week during the Review Period October 16, 2023, some meals served during the week reviewed did not meet the appropriate daily and weekly meal pattern requirements for the age/grade group(s) being served. Serving sizes were changed depending on the grade level of the students. Younger students received a smaller portion size to reduce waste. It was explained all students have a minimum serving size based on USDA rules.

Technical Assistance:

The school was provided technical assistance during the on-site visit and changes made.

1406. Most recent Food safety inspection posted, visible to public?

Finding 9147: Most recent food safety inspection report is not posted in a publicly visible location.

The most recent Health Inspection must be posted for public view. This was not being done. This was explained to Tasha Higgins, the Food Service Director.

Corrective Action:

Submit to the reviewer a picture of the most recent Health Inspection were posted for public view.

Ghost Tray: Maine Child Nutrition requires a ghost tray be maintained. A ghost tray is a sample of each meal component offered to the students for each meal, each day. They are required to be kept for 48 hours. The reason for the ghost tray is for testing if a food borne illness is suspected.
