STATEMENT OF FACT

RSU 14 Superintendent Christopher Howell requests that the State Board of Education grant Design and Funding Approval for Phase 1 Site Development for a new grades 5-8 Middle School to be constructed in the Town of Windham.

Windham Middle School (grades 6-8) rated 5th on the Final Priority List of the 2017-2018 Rating Cycle and was placed on the Approved Projects List at the November 4, 2020 State Board of Education meeting. The project received State Board of Education Site Approval on July 12, 2023 and Concept Approval on September 13, 2023. The project was approved by local referendum vote on November 7, 2023.

It has been recommended that in the best interest of the project the construction be separated into two phases. Phase 1 Site Development Approval will permit the extensive site work required for the project to move more quickly than waiting for approval of the site and building combined. The earlier approval will take advantage of summer weather and a positive bidding environment of site-specific contractors and will also allow students to occupy the school one year earlier than they would have had the work on the site waited for Design and Funding Approval of the entire project.

The major site design elements of the project have not changed since Concept Approval. There have been several changes through the site engineering process that have resulted in cost efficiencies, improved traffic circulation, and student safety.

Design and Funding Approval for Phase 1 Site Development is being requested pursuant to MRS Title 20-A §15905(1) and State Board of Education Rule, Chapter 61, Rules for Major Capital School Construction Projects.
